We are part of the University of Cambridge, trusted for excellence in education. Our qualifications are recognised by the world's universities and employers.

- Over **9000** schools in over **160** countries around the world offer Cambridge qualifications.
- We are a division of Cambridge Assessment, a **not-for-profit** organisation and part of the world renowned University of Cambridge.
- Cambridge Primary is taught in over **650** schools worldwide.
- Every year we receive more than **54000** entries for Cambridge Checkpoint, our tests for 11 to 14 year olds.
- 2013 marks the **25th** anniversary of the first Cambridge IGCSE® exam.
- Cambridge IGCSE is the world's most popular international qualification for 14 to 16 year olds. It is taken in **140** countries and in more than **3700** schools around the world.
- There are almost **500000** subject entries for Cambridge IGCSE exams each year.
- We are the world's biggest provider of O Level. Cambridge O Level is taken in **80** countries.
- Cambridge International AS and A Levels are taken in **125** countries with **350000** subject entries each year.
